



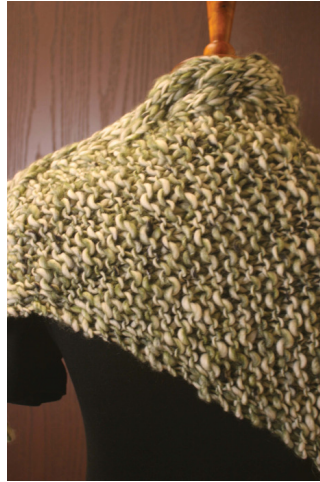

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Clue schedule:

Clue #1 11/1/2019

Clue #2 11/8/2019

Clue #3 11/15/2019

Materials:

Size 13 U.S. 32" circular needle

Cable needle

Yarn:

3 hanks Trendsetter Yarns ME (100% superwash wool, 75 yards, 100 grams), in a single color of your choice.

Gauge:

12 sts = 4" worked in garter stitch on smaller needles swatched flat.

Please note you do not need to obtain row gauge for this pattern.

MYSTERY CLUE 1:

With #13 needle and Me, Cast on 10sts in desired method.

- Row 1: (WS)-K1,p8, k1.
- Row 2: (RS)-Kfb. K to end.
- Row 3: K1,p8, k2.
- Row 4: Kfb. K to end.
- Row 5: K1,p8. Knit to end.
- Row 6: Kfb. K to end of row.
- Row 7: K1,p8. Knit to end.
- Row 8: Kfb. Knit until last 8sts. C8F.

Continue working rows as follows:

- Row 9: (WS) K1,P8. K to end.
- Row 10: (RS) Kfb. K to end.

Repeat Rows 9-10 two more times.

- Row 15: K1,p8. Knit to end.
- Row 16: Kfb. Knit to last 8sts. C8F.

Repeat Rows 9-16 until you have increased to 41sts total or less depending on how far the first skein of yarn allows. Please make sure to end with an "odd" number of stitches before Mystery Clue #2.

Mystery #1 – Stitch Guide:

- C8F – Slip 4 stitches to Cn and hold in front. K4. K4 from Cn.
- Cn - Cable Needle
- K- Knit
- Kfb – Knit front and back of same stitch to increase.
- P- Purl
- RS – Right side of work.
- Sts - Stitches
- WS – Wrong side of work.

MYSTERY CLUE 2:

Work 1 WS row before starting Clue 2. Clue 2 is a continuation of work from Clue 1 reveal and is not a separate piece.

Section One:

Row 1: (RS) Kfb. *Yo, k2-tog*. Rep *to* until last 10sts. K10sts.

Row 2: (WS) K1. P to last stitch. K1.

Row 3: Kfb. K1. *Yo,k2-tog*. Rep *to* until last 10sts. K10sts.

Row 4: K1. P to last stitch. K1.

Row 5-6: Repeat rows 1-2 once more.

Row 7: Kfb, k1, *yo,k2-tog*. Rep *to* to last 10sts. K1, C4F, C4B, k1.

Row 8: K1. P to last stitch. K1.

Repeat Rows 1-8 until 48sts are on the needle or 7 additional stitches from ending number of stitches from Clue 1.

Section Two:

Row 1: (RS) Ssk, k1. *Yo, Ssk*. Rep *to* until 9sts remain. K to end.

Row 2: (WS) K1. P to last stitch. K1.

Row 3: Ssk, k1. *Yo, Ssk*. Rep *to* to last 10sts. K to end.

Row 4: K1. P to last stitch. K1.

Row 5-6: Repeat rows 1-2 once more.

Row 7: Ssk, k1. *Yo, Ssk*. Rep *to* to last 10sts. K1. C4F, C4B, k1.

Row 8: K1. P to last stitch. K1.

Repeat rows 1-8 until 41sts are on the needle or matching number of stitches from end of Clue 1 and ending with a WS row. There may still be some yarn remaining at this point.

Mystery #2 – Stitch Guide:

C4F – Slip 2 stitches to Cn and hold in front. K2. K2 from Cn.

C4B – Slip 2 stitches to Cn and hold in back. K2. K2 from Cn.

Cn - Cable Needle

K- Knit

K2-tog - Knit 2sts together through front of stitches.

Kfb – Knit front and back of same stitch to increase.

P- Purl

RS – Right side of work

Rep – Repeat

Ssk – Slip 1 stitch as to knit. Slip next stitch as to knit. Insert tip of left needle into front of two slipped sts on right needle and K2-tog through the back loops.

Sts- Stitches

tog - Together

WS – Wrong side of work.

Yo- Yarn over (wrap yarn around needle as if to knit a stitch.)

MYSTERY CLUE 3:

If any yarn remains from Mystery Clue 2, continue until yarn is finished and join new skein to finish Clue 3.

Row 1: (RS) Ssk. K to last 8sts. K3, p1, k4.

Row 2: (WS) K1, p3, k1, p3. *K6, p6*. Rep *to* as possible to end of row. (Note that the pattern will not end with a complete repeat as stitch count changes.)

Row 3: Ssk. K to last 8sts. Slip 1 as to purl. k2. Pss0 the K2. P1. Slip 1 as to purl. K2. Pss0 the k2. K1.

Row 4: K1, p1, yo, p1, k1, p1, yo, p1, *k6, p6*. Rep *to* as possible to end of row.

Repeat rows 1-4 until 10sts remain. Bind off.

Mystery #3 – Stitch Guide:

K- Knit

P- Purl

Pss0 - Pass the slipped stitch over

RS – Right side of work

Rep – Repeat

Ssk – Slip 1 stitch as to knit. Slip another stitch as to knit. Put point of left needle into front of two slipped sts on right needle and K2-tog through the back.

Sts- Stitches

Tog - Together

WS – Wrong side of work.

Yo- Yarn over (wrap yarn around needle as if to knit a stitch.)

Finishing:

Weave in all loose ends. Take balance of yarn and cut pieces 8" in length. Attach 1 piece to each cast on stitch as fringe. Gather tails and knot to gather them. Repeat fringe for bind off edge. Take balance of yarn and tassel into the center point and knot together.
