# “TOPPER” FREE PATTERN VARIATIONS

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Ribbed Hat

### **RIBBED POINT SCARF (Brown):**

#### **Trendsetter Yarns Used:**

Topper-2/50gr. Brown

Needles #10.5

With #10.5 needle and Topper, Cast on 4sts. Work in K2/P2 Rib St., Increasing 1 stitch each end every other until 26sts are on the needle. Continue in Rib St. until scarf is 50-54" from the last increase. Continue in pattern, decreasing 1 stitch each end every other row until 4sts remain. Bind off in pattern. Sew Pom Pom to each end.

#### **Rib St.:**

Row 1: \*K2,P2\*. Row 2: Work stitches as they appear on the needle.

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### **MISTAKE RIB SCARF (Blue):**

#### **Trendsetter Yarns Used:**

Topper-2/50gr. Blue

Needles #10.5

With #10.5 needle and Topper, Cast on 100sts loosely and evenly. Work in the following Corrugated Garter St. pattern until enough yarn remains to bind off. Work bind off as follows: Bind off 90sts on next row. Cut tail and pull through last bound off stitch. Pull remaining stitches from the needle and unknit them so that they create long loops at the end of the scarf. Cut ends of loops and knot each pair at the top to create fringe. Attach one Pom Pom to each end.

#### **Corrugated Garter St.:**

Row 1: Purl across the row. Row 2: Knit across the row.

Row 3: Knit across the row. Row 4: Purl across the row.

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### **ANGLED GARTER SCARF (Red):**

#### **Trendsetter Yarns Used:**

Topper-2/50gr. Red

Needles #10.5

With #10.5 needle and Topper, Cast on 120sts loosely and evenly. Work in the following pattern until enough yarn remains to bind off. Bind off loosely and evenly. Attach a Pom Pom to each point.

#### **Angled Garter St.:**

Row 1: Knit 1 increasing in first stitch. Knit until 3sts remain. K2-tog, K1. Row 2: Knit across the row.

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### **RIBBED HAT (Black):**

#### **Trendsetter Yarns Used:**

Topper-1/50gr. Black

Needles #10

With #10 needle and Topper, Cast on 66(70,74)sts. Work in K2/P2 Rib St., until hat is 8(9,10)". Thread tail through sewing needle and pull through all stitches on the needle. Remove needle and pull tightly to gather top of hat. Sew Pom Pom in place.

#### **Rib St.:**

Row 1: \*K2,P2\*.

Row 2: Work stitches as they appear on the needle.

### **ANGLED RIB HAT (Brown):**

#### **Trendsetter Yarns Used:**

Topper-1/50gr. Brown

Needles #10

With #10 needle and Topper, Cast on 46sts. Work in the following Rib pattern until 16(17,18)" from the cast on. Bind off at the end of one pattern. Sew cast on edge to bind off edge creating a long tall tube. Thread strong fiber through sewing needle and work a running stitch in/out of top edge of hat and pull tightly to gather. Sew Pom Pom to gather point at top of hat.

#### **Angled Rib St.:**

Row 1: Knit 1 increasing in first stitch. Knit until 3sts remain. K2-tog, K1.

Row 2: Purl across the row.

Repeat rows 1-2 2x total

Row 5: Purl 1 Increasing in first stitch. Purl until 3sts remain. P2-tog,P1.

Row 6: Knit across the row.

Repeat rows 5-6 2x total.

Repeat Rows 1-8 for pattern.

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### **RUFFLED SCARF (Black):**

Topper Black 2-3/50gr.

Needles #10

With #10 needle and Topper, Cast on 24sts. Knit 1 row. Work as follows:

Row 1: Cast on 3/Bind off 3 to create tail, K9sts more.

Row 2: Turn and knit to end of row.

Row 3: Sl.1 as if to Purl, K6sts more.

Row 4: Turn and knit to end of row.

Row 5: Cast on 3/Bind off 3 to create tail, K3sts more.

Row 6: Turn and knit to end of row.

Row 7: Sl.1 as if to Purl and knit across the complete row to other side.

Repeat from Row 1, working short rows alternating from side to side as fibers flow from side to side. Continue to desired length and bind off after working a complete repeat. Our sample scarf was worked with 2 skeins and is a short scarf. Full length scarf would require 3 skeins.

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### **SEED ST. HAT (Olive)**

1-skn Topper Olive

Needles #9

With #9 needle and Topper (use thread from outside of ball), Cast on 11sts. Work 1 row Seed St. Pull tail from inside of ball. Join and work 2 rows of Seed St. Alternate working yarn from inside and outside every 2 rows until band is 22" or desired length to go around the head. Bind off.

With #9 needle and Topper, Pick up 65sts along the long edge of border. Work in Seed St. for 1". Continue in Seed St., working as follows:

\*7sts Seed St., (work 2sts-together)2x\*. Repeat across the row as possible.

Work Seed St. for 1".

\*6sts Seed St., (work 2sts-together)2x\*. Repeat across the row as possible.

Work Seed St. for 1".

\*5sts Seed St., (work 2sts-together)2x\*. Repeat across the row as possible.

Work Seed St. for 1".

\*4sts Seed St., (work 2sts-together)2x\*. Repeat across the row as possible.

Work Seed St. for 1".

Cut a long tail. Thread tail and run through all remaining stitches on the needle and pull tightly to gather. Knot top of hat and use thread to sew seam down hat. At bottom border, fold up border in half and sew through both thicknesses to secure. Sew Pom Pom to top of hat.

### **MULTI DIRECTIONAL SCARF:**

2-skn Topper Olive  
Needles #10

With #10 needle and Topper, Cast on 3sts. Work as follows:

Row 1: K1 Increase in stitch. Knit the row.

Row 2: K1 Increase in stitch. Knit the row.

Repeat Increasing in first stitch and knitting the row until 24sts are on the needle or desired with and ending with an even number of stitches.

(+)For next direction, work as follows:

Row 1: K1 Increase in stitch. SSK.

Row 2: Turn and knit 3.

Row 3: K1 Increase in stitch, K1, SSK.

Row 4: Turn and knit 4.

Row 5: K1 Increase in stitch, K2, SSK.

Row 6: Turn and knit 5.

Continue in this manner Increasing in first stitch and working 1 additional stitch before working an SSK to close the gap and join new direction to old direction. Continue until all stitches have been covered and end of row is worked with SSK. Turn work and begin from (+).

Continue working from (+) over and over until desired length. Our scarf was worked from (+) 11x total. Turn and work 1 more, stopping when stitches are split with 12sts on right needle after SSK and 12sts not worked from last direction. On next Increase/SSK row, work as follows:

Row 1: SSK. Work until 1 stitch before SSK. Work SSK to join.

Row 2: Turn and work back.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until all stitches are gone and scarf ends. Bind off and bury tails.
