YARN:

Lana Grossa Tutti – 1/100gr.

**MATERIALS:** 

Needles U.S. #10

SIZES:

Tall: 26" wide x 9" tall Wide: 35" wide x 7" tall GAUGE:

With #10 needle and Tutti in Stock St.; 15sts x 24rows = 4".

STITCHES USED:

Stock St.:

Row 1: (RS) Knit across the row. Row 2: (WS) Purl across the row.

#### **PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS:**

#### **Designer Note:**

The directions for this project will use one skein of the yarn listed, however you can easily make adjustments to the dimensions by using more or less units in the round or tiers in the project. Just be aware that changes will result in changes to yardage requirements.

#### **Construction Notes**

The scarf is a tube of entrelac seamed together at the end to form a loop scarf. The project begins and ends with complete rectangles that seam in a manner to mimic entrelac fabric. The tube is not joined in the round until completing the last unit of the second tier. This allows for enough fabric to have been created minimizing the possibility of twisting.

#### **Special Abbreviations**

PUK – Pick up and knit PUP – Pick up and purl

NOTE: All entrelac units are worked in stockinette stitch, turn work after each row unless specifically otherwise noted.

#### Right-Leaning Rectangle (RR)

Setup row (WS): PUP 15 (12) sts along edge of unit in previous tier.

Row 1 and all RS rows: Knit.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl to last st of RR, p2tog (1 st from RR with 1 st from unit in previous tier).

Rep RS and WS rows for a total of 30 (24) rows.

#### Left-Leaning Rectangle (LR)

Setup Row (RS): PUK 15 (12) sts along edge of unit in previous tier.

Row 1 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 2 and all RS rows: Knit to last st of LR, SSK (1 st from LR with 1 st from unit in previous tier).

Rep WS and RS rows for a total of 30 (24) rows.

## **Tube Scarf**

**Tier 1**: \* CO 15 (12) sts. Beginning with a WS row, work a total of 30 (24) rows in stockinette stitch. Without breaking yarn, repeat from \* 2 more times starting with knit style Cast On for each rectangle – 3 rectangles completed.

On last rectangle, turn work and purl one additional WS row.

Technical Tip: Completing this maneuver will postpone joining the work until the conclusion of Tier 2 when it is easier to prevent the fabric from twisting and eliminates the need to cut the yarn.

**Tier 2:** Work 2 RR units. Work one more RR making sure fabric is not twisted and joining stitches across the break. Work 1 additional row to eliminate the need to cut the yarn.

**Tier 3**: Work 3 LR units working an additional row on the last unit of the tier.

Tier 4: Work 3 RR units working an additional row on the last unit of the tier.

Repeat Tiers 3&4 2 (10) more times, BO all sts on the last row of each unit in Tier 8 (14).

#### **Finishing**

Forming a loop, seam CO and BO zigzag edges together joining sts to rows and rows to sts to maintain look of entrelac fabric. Weave in any remaining ends. Block as desired.
